MOSTLY MUTTS ANIMAL RESCUE ANNOUNCES 2nd ANNUAL "PUTTS FOR MUTTS" GOLF TOURNAMENT ON MAY 20, 2019 AND ADDS A TENNIS TOURNAMENT TO THE MIX

KENNESAW – Thanks to overwhelming support for the inaugural event last year, Mostly Mutts Animal Rescue is getting ready for its second annual "Putts for Mutts" golf tournament. This year, they have also added a tennis tournament - "Matches for Mutts." Both events are scheduled for Monday, May 20 at Brookstone Golf and Country Club in Acworth. The registration for golf begins at 7:30 am with a 9:00 am shotgun start. The format remains a 4-person team scramble. Tennis players register at 9:30 am and begin play at 10:30 am. The entry fee for golfers is \$150 per person (\$600 per team) which includes green fee, cart, tee gift, breakfast, lunch, refreshments and raffle tickets. The entry fee for tennis players is \$50 per person which includes refreshments during play, a tennis gift bag, raffle tickets and lunch. Sponsor opportunities are also available.

Mostly Mutts strives to reduce the number of animals euthanized at local shelters in Metro Atlanta by working with animal control officers to save adoptable dogs that are moments away from being put to sleep. Often, these dogs are sick, injured and require rehabilitation. Mostly Mutts provides housing, health care, training, and physical and emotional care to these rescued animals until they can be placed in a new "furever home."

Mostly Mutts is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, licensed by the Dept. of Agriculture and staffed by volunteers. It is privately funded through donations and adoption fees.
