MOSTLY MUTTS ANIMAL RESCUE GAINS COMMUNITY SUPPORT IN NEW LOCATION, COLLECTS 4,525 PAIRS OF SHOES

KENNESAW – Since moving to its new location in downtown Kennesaw in February, Mostly Mutts has seen an outpouring of support from the local community.

A shoe drive was held from March 15 to May 15 with a goal of collecting 2,500 pairs of gently used shoes. Thanks to the efforts of companies and individuals from all over the Atlanta area, the drive was a huge success and a total of 4,525 pairs were collected! Funds2Orgs will donate money to Mostly Mutts in exchange for the shoe collection, and the donated shoes will be shipped to developing nations to the Funds2Orgs network of microenterprise partners. Mostly Mutts thanks every individual, business and all the volunteers who helped us exceed the goal by 80%.

Other examples of community support during April and May included fundraisers by KSU fraternity Delta Sigma Phi (“First Annual KSU Dog Days”); Odyssey Transportation Solutions (“Multi-Modal Pet Walk”) and The Canine Ranch (“Play Pass to benefit Mostly Mutts”).

“We are delighted to be partnering with so many businesses in our community” said Tammy Turley, Executive Director. “We are well on our way to a record setting year of successful adoptions. Every donated item, volunteer hour, foster family and adopter helps us in our goal to save more animals.”

Mostly Mutts strives to reduce the number of animals euthanized at local shelters in Metro Atlanta by working with animal control officers to save adoptable dogs that are moments away from being put to sleep. Often, these dogs are sick, injured and require rehabilitation. Mostly Mutts provides housing, health care, training, and physical and emotional care to these rescued animals until they can be placed in a new “forever home.”
Since 2004, Mostly Mutts has saved approximately 5,500 animals.

Mostly Mutts is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, licensed by the Dept. of Agriculture and staffed by volunteers. It is privately funded through donations and adoption fees.
