MOSTLY MUTTS ANIMAL RESCUE RECEIVES GRANTS FROM LGE COMMUNITY OUTREACH FOUNDATION, PEDIGREE FOUNDATION, AND REPORTS A 40% INCREASE IN ADOPTIONS FOR 2017

KENNESAW – Finishing the year with a “bang,” Mostly Mutts reported a 40% increase in adoptions in 2017 with more than 700 animals finding new, loving homes. Dogs, cats, rabbits, birds, guinea pigs and even a Shetland pony were among the adopted animals.

Mostly Mutts was very grateful to be one of the beneficiaries of the LGE Community Outreach Foundation’s fundraising efforts in 2017. The money received will be used to extend the Mostly Mutts University program where dogs get trained in basic commands while waiting to be adopted. Mostly Mutts also received a grant from the Pedigree Foundation in December of 2017.

“We have had an incredibly successful 2017 and are excited to see what the New Year will bring. Our amazing team of volunteers have worked 57,000 hours over the past year, an average of 156 hours a day”, said Tammy Turley, Executive Director. “I am humbled by the tremendous support we receive from volunteers, foster families, donors and adopters. There are so many people who care deeply about the needs of homeless pets who don’t have a voice. I never expected that we would exceed last year’s adoption numbers by 40%. We have so much to be thankful for,” said Tammy.

*Mostly Mutts strives to reduce the number of animals euthanized at local shelters in Metro Atlanta by working with animal control officers to save adoptable dogs that are moments away from being put to sleep. Often, these dogs are sick, injured and require rehabilitation. Mostly Mutts provides housing, health care, training, and physical and emotional care to these rescued animals until they can be placed in a new “forever home.” **Since 2004, Mostly Mutts has saved approximately 7,500 animals.***

Mostly Mutts is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, licensed by the Dept. of Agriculture and staffed by volunteers. It is privately funded through donations and adoption fees.
